NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2014

Though the Napa Valley is geographically small, its diverse topography and variety of soils make it possible to grow Cabernet Sauvignon in one vineyard that is remarkably distinct from Cabernet grown at another site. We tap into these vast differences among vineyards with the 2014 Torial Cabernet Sauvignon, which opens with aromas of dark berry, chocolate-covered cherry, vanilla, dried dill weed, blond caramel and a hint of eucalyptus before surrendering to rich and generous flavors of black raspberry, licorice, just-baked blueberry scone, espresso, dark-brown sugar and anise. The supple mouthfeel is complemented by satisfying mid-palate weight and firm, but not insistent, tannins. The medium-long finish adds final notes of opulence and grace.

SONOMA COUNTY RED WINE 2014

As a tribute to Sonoma County's rich heritage of grape-growing and winemaking, we brought together old-vine Zinfandel, Grenache and Carignane to create this luxurious, supple and full-bodied wine. Our Torial 2014 Sonoma County Red Wine delivers enticing aromas of chocolate-covered cherries, pie spice, anise and roasted fig. Bold flavors of ripe raspberry, boysenberry cobbler, pomegranate, cocoa powder and vanilla linger harmoniously, leading to a smooth, integrated and luscious finish.
